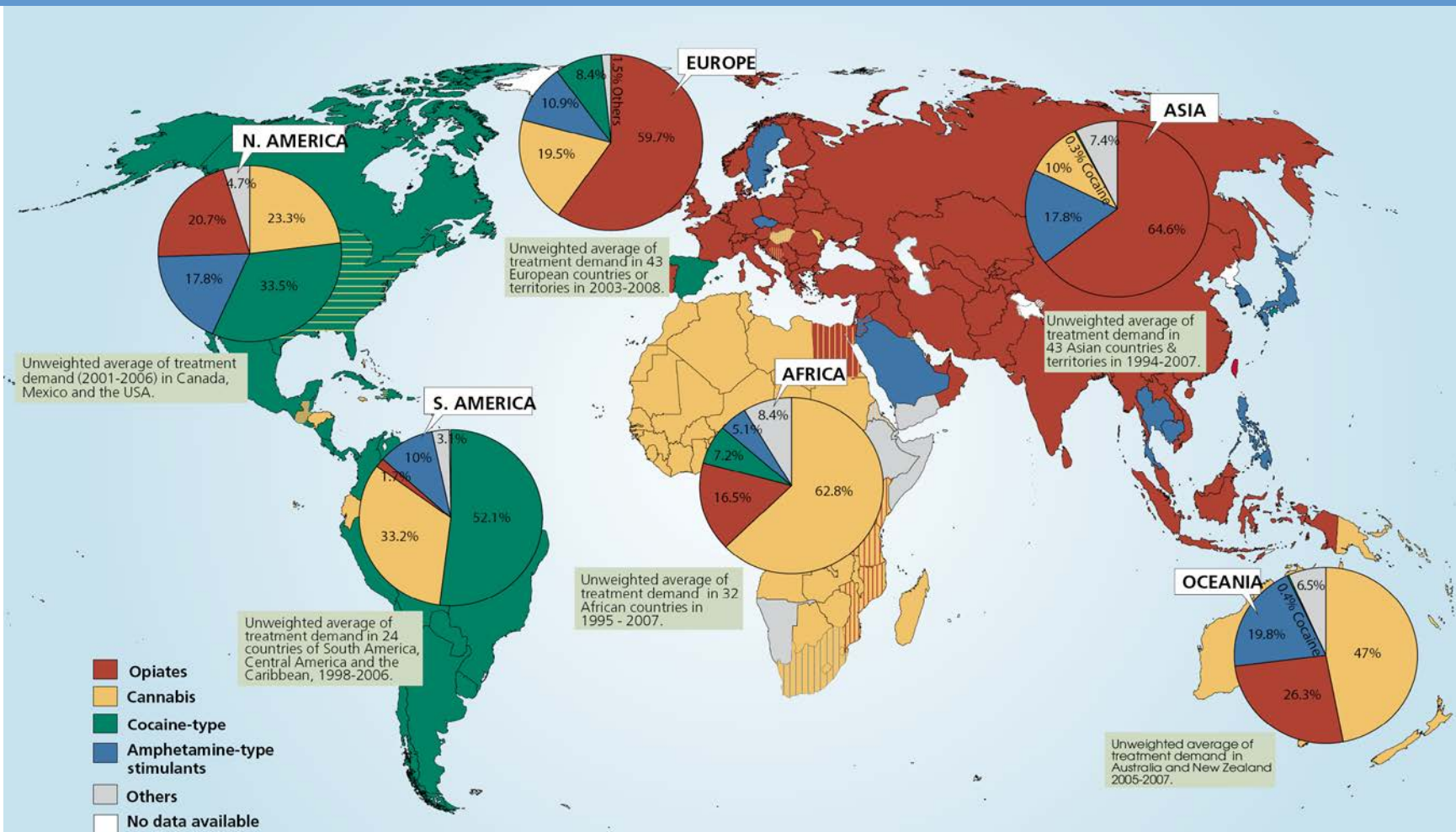

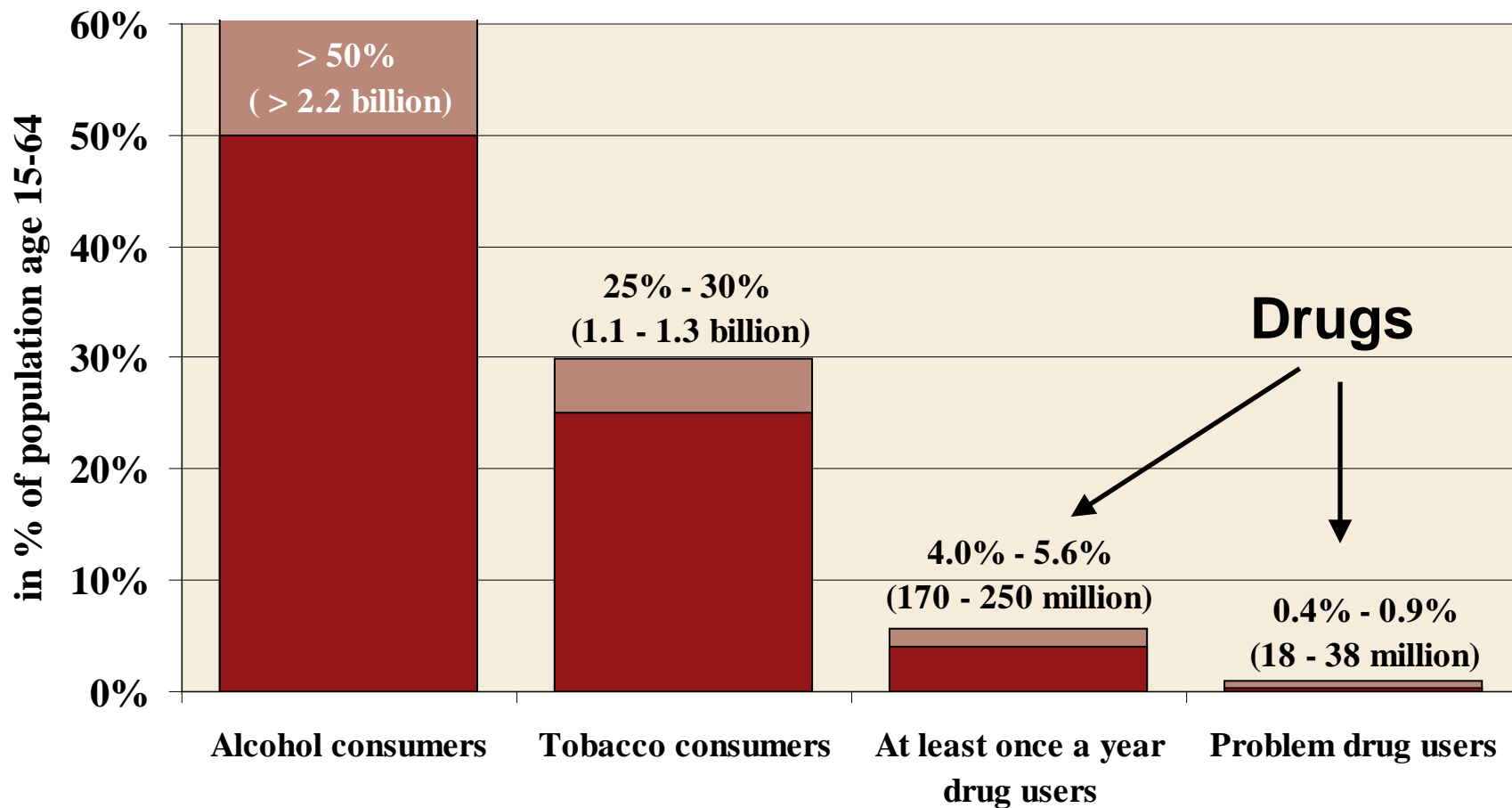
Problem drugs in the world



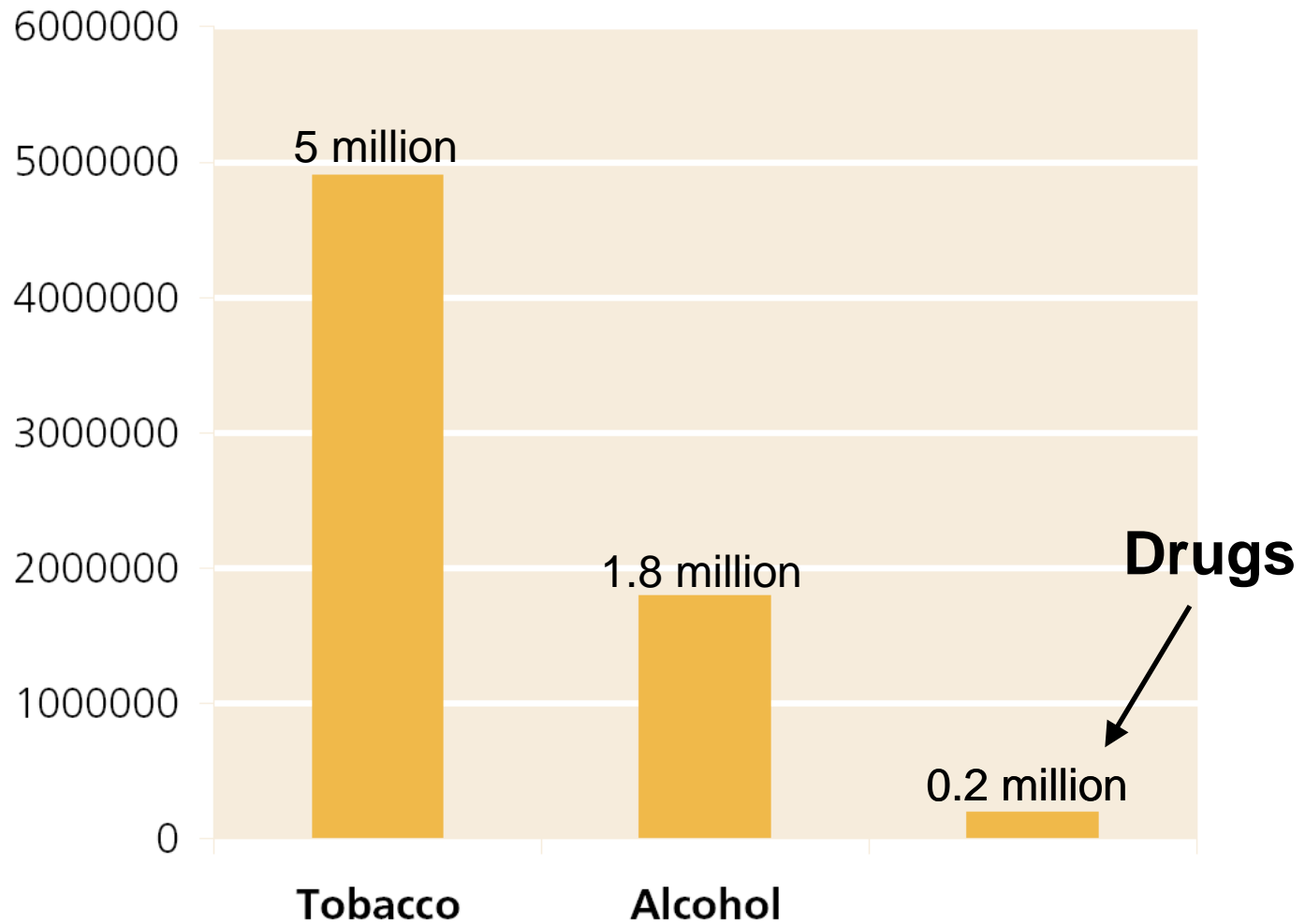

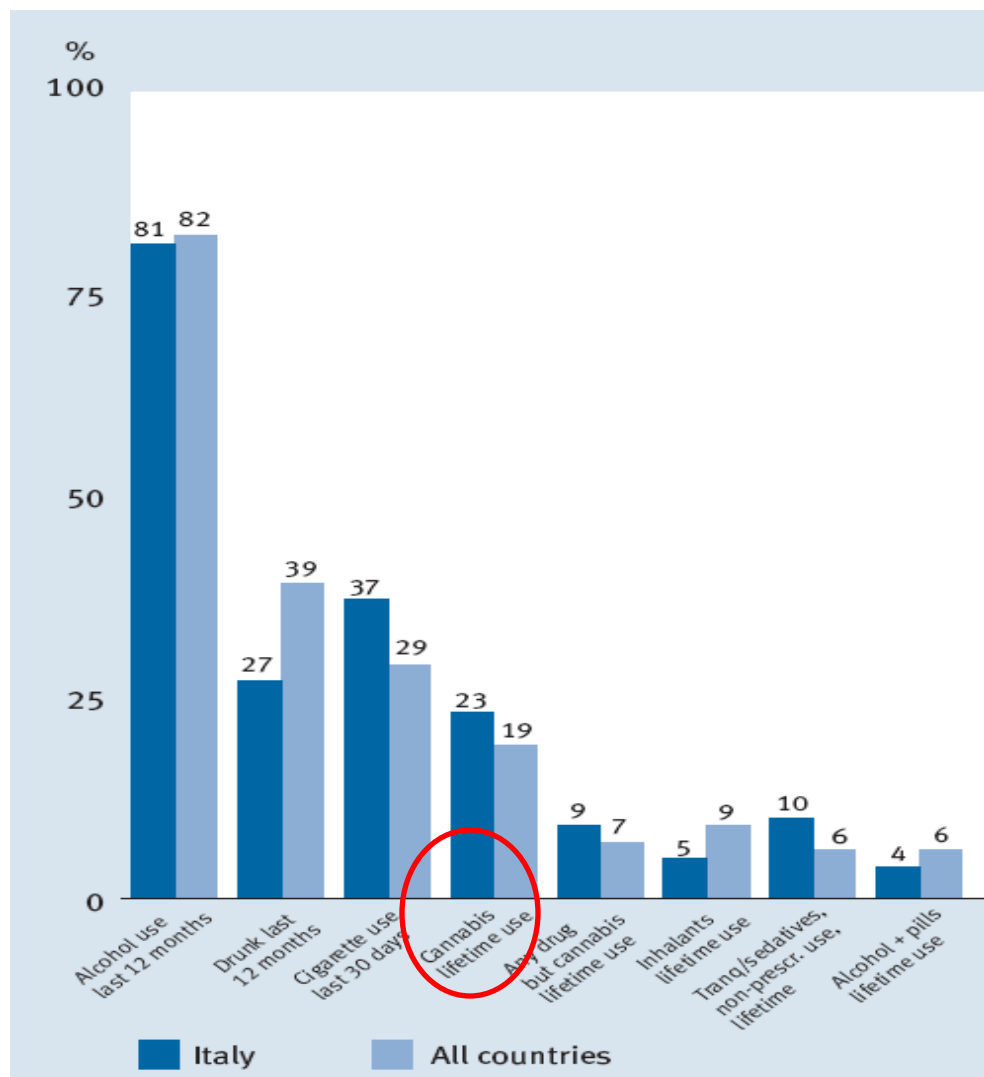
Global use of psychoactive substances 2007



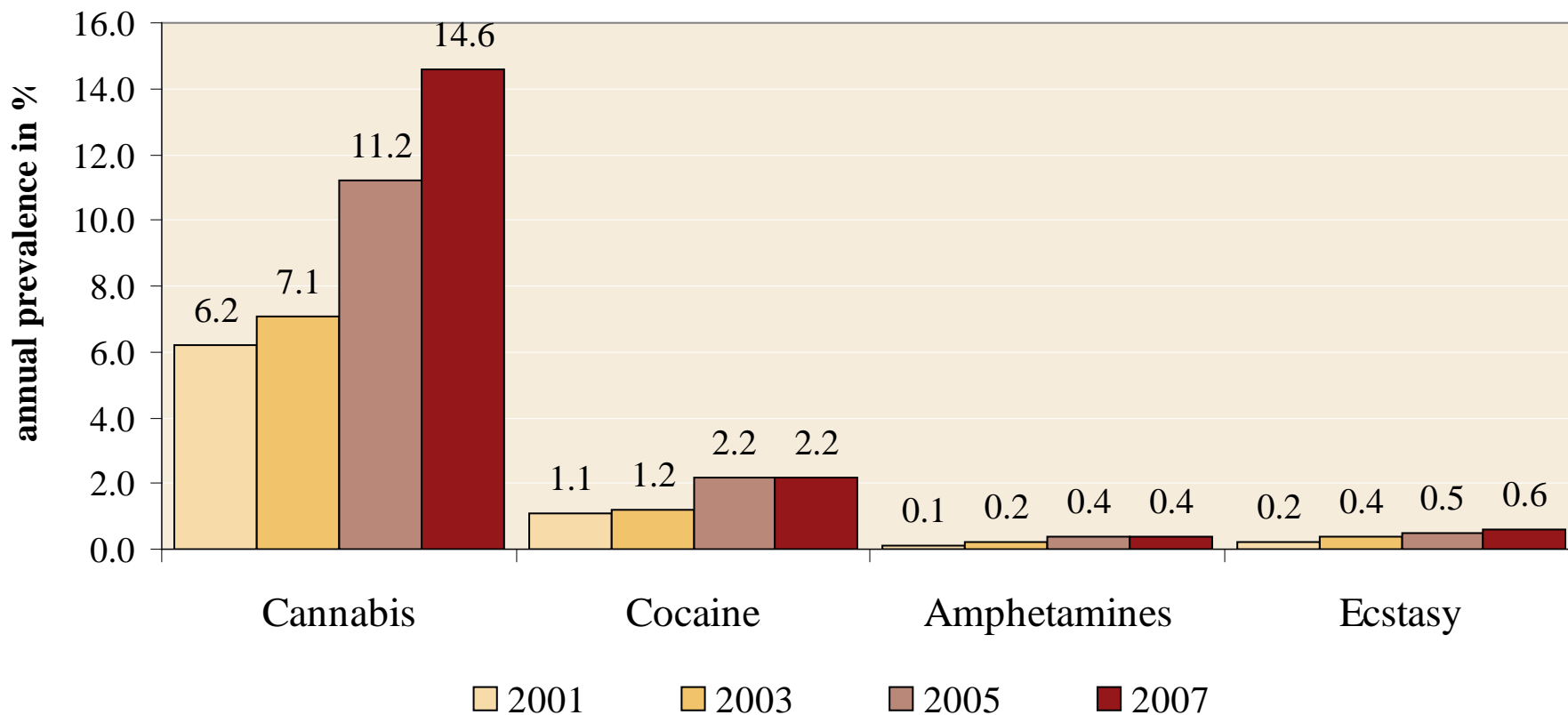
Global deaths related to substance abuse



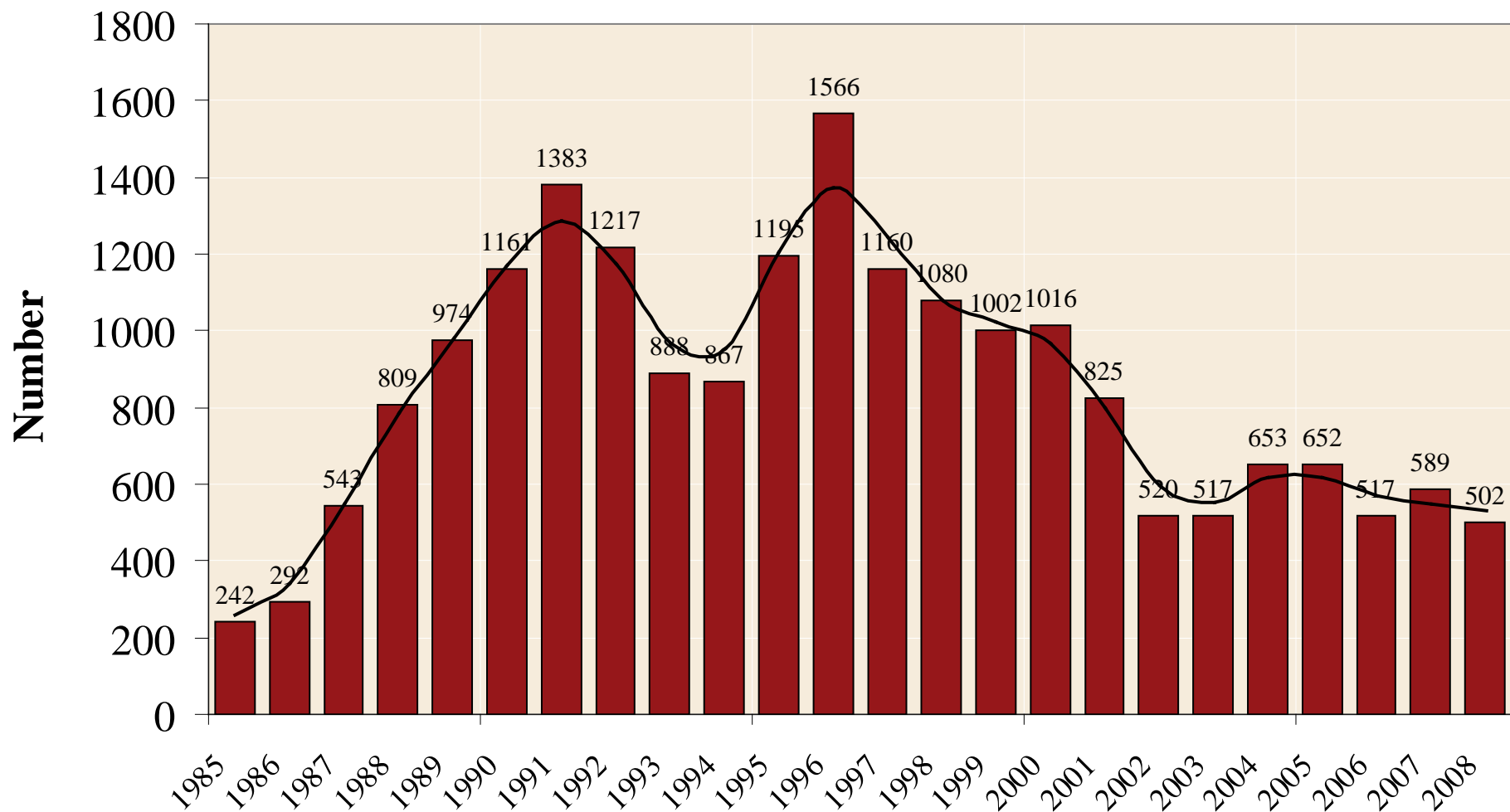
Substance use in Europe among 15-16 year old students, 2007



Annual prevalence of illicit drug use in Italy, 2001-2007

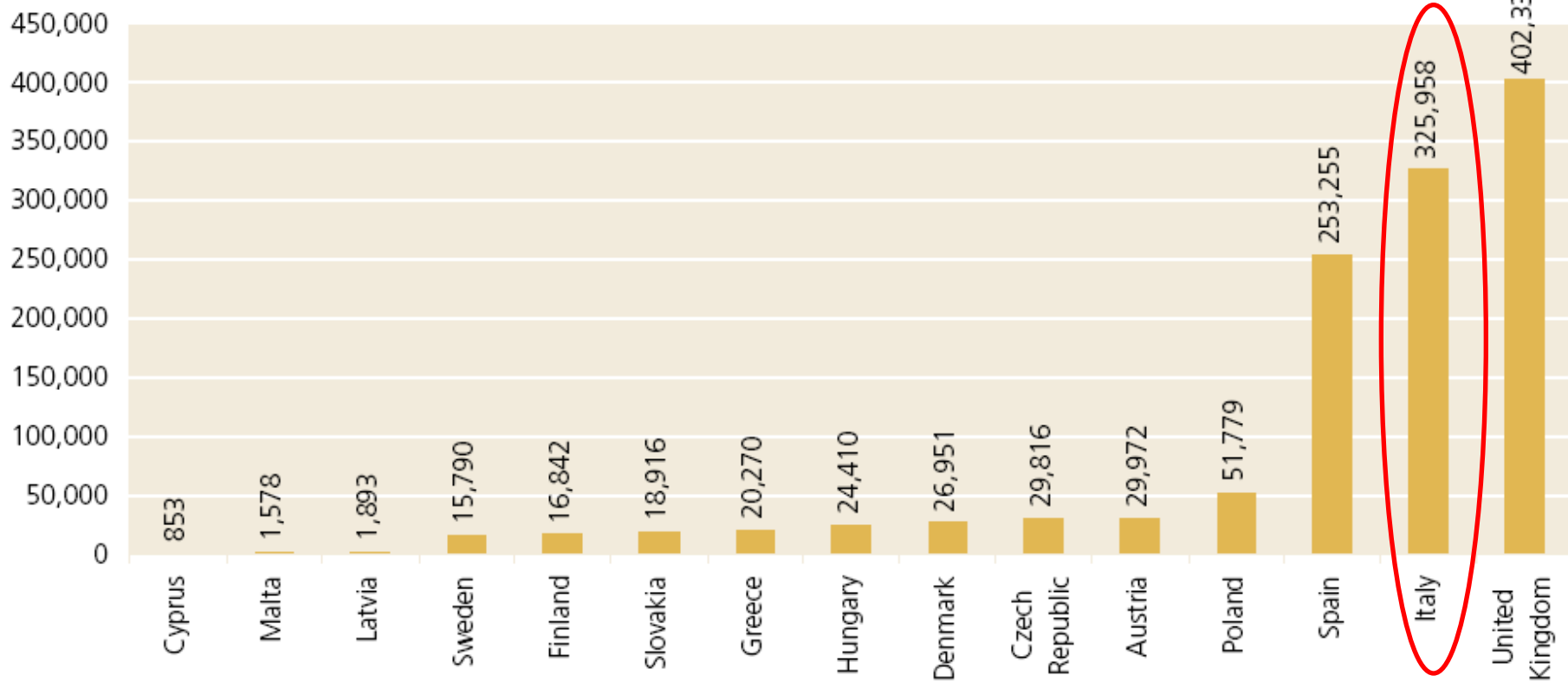


Number of drug-induced deaths in Italy, 1985-2008

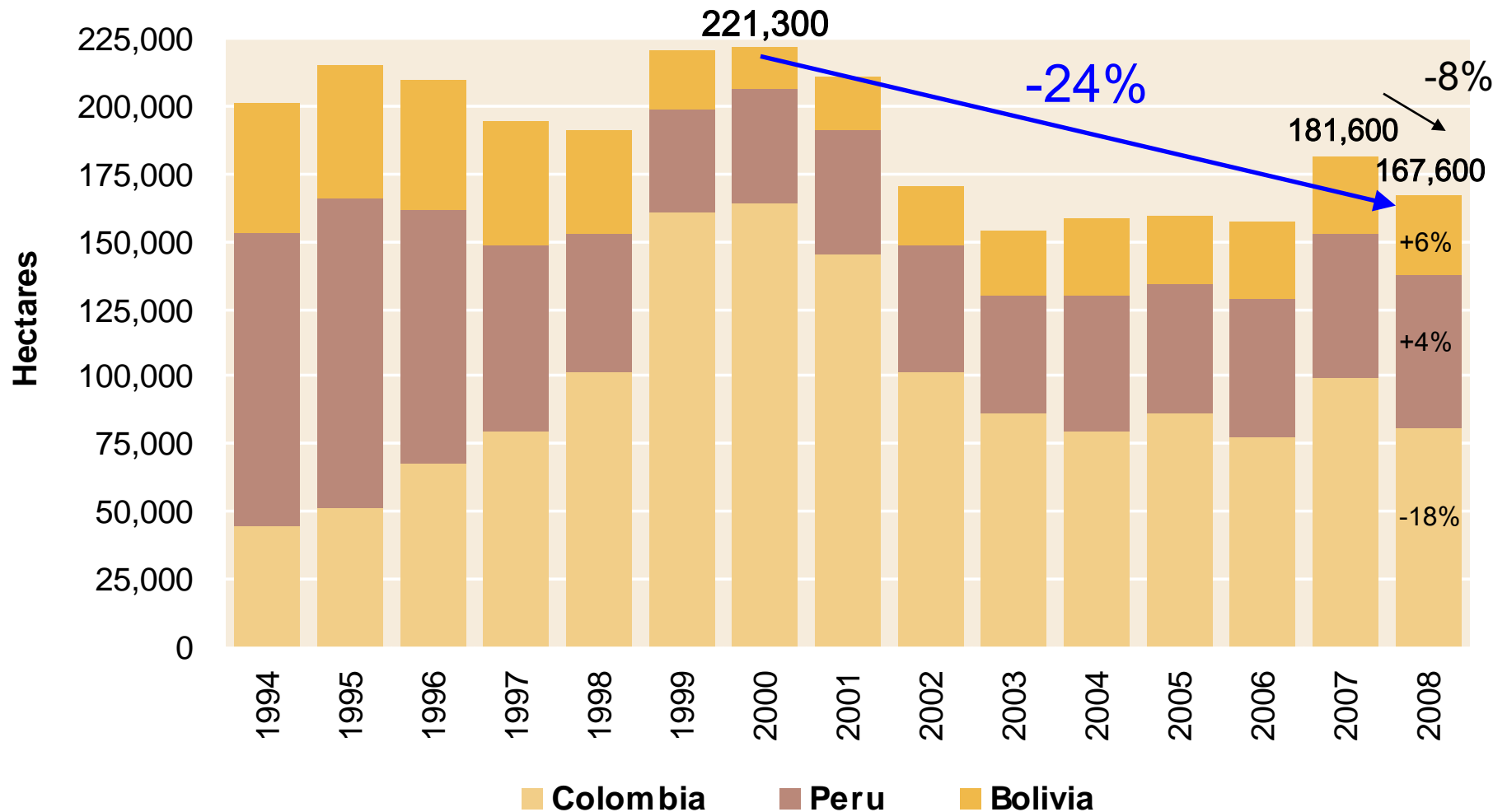


Number of 'problem drug users' 2002-08

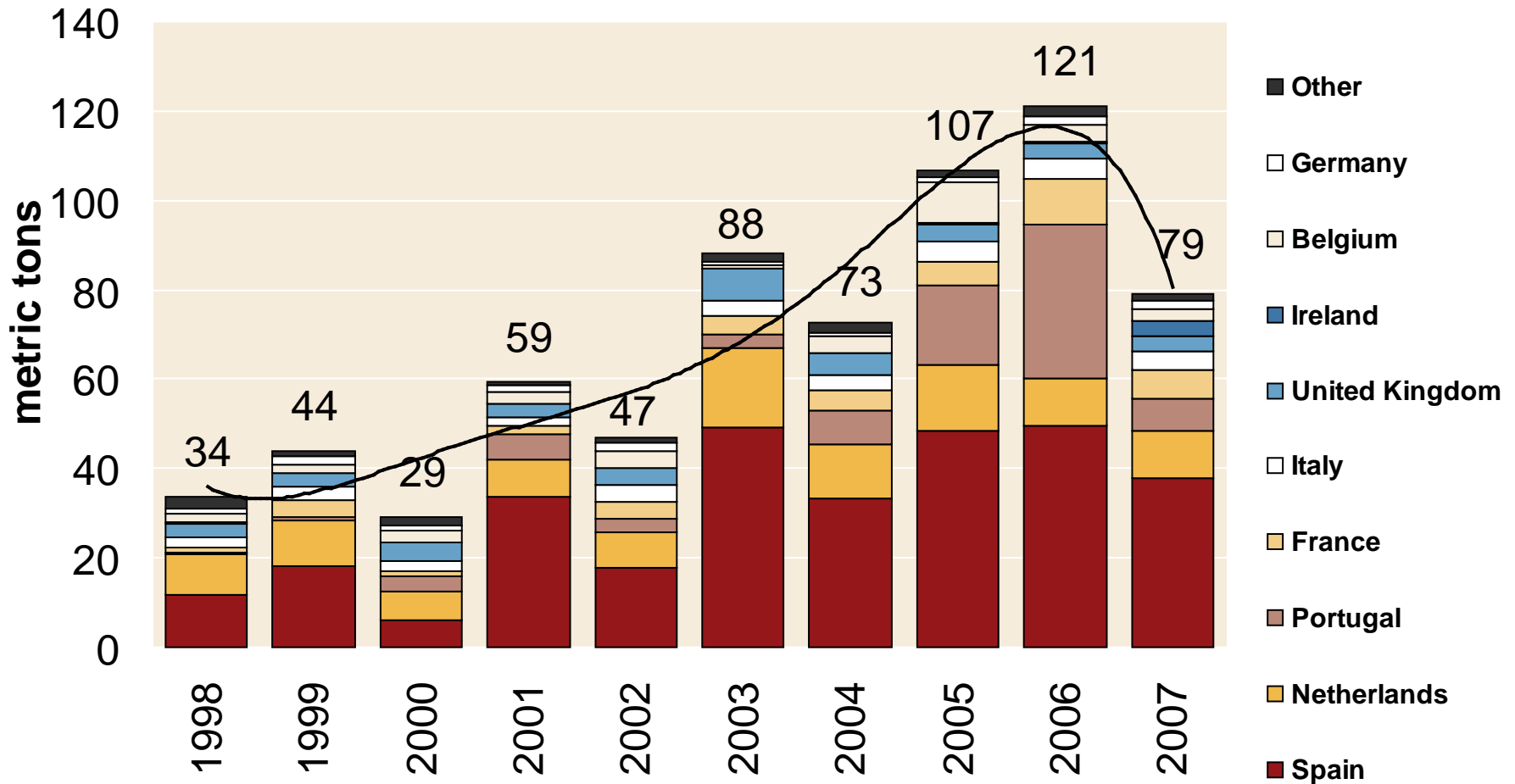

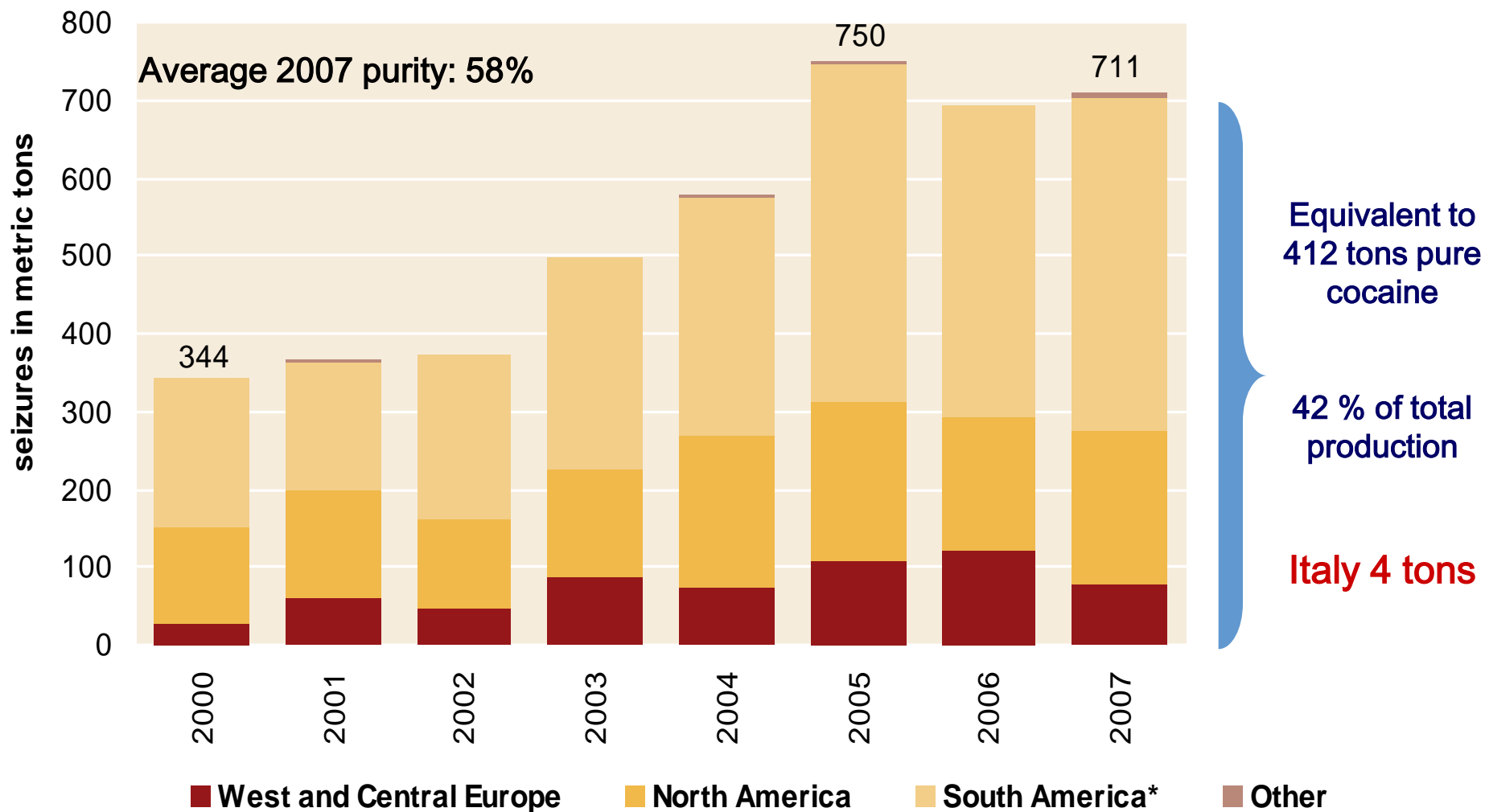
Lower coca cultivation in 2008



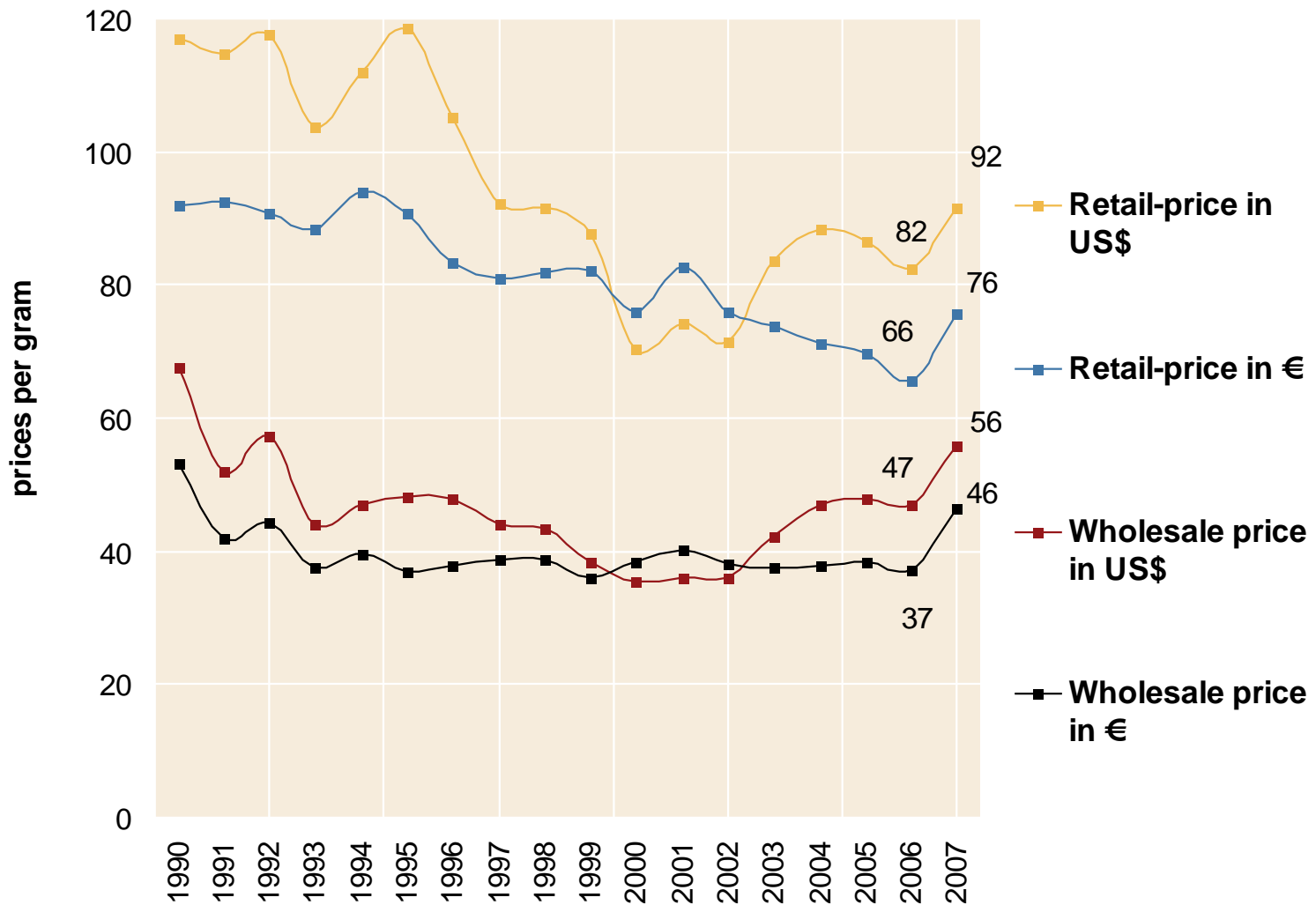
Cocaine seizures in Europe 1998 - 2007



Very high cocaine seizures

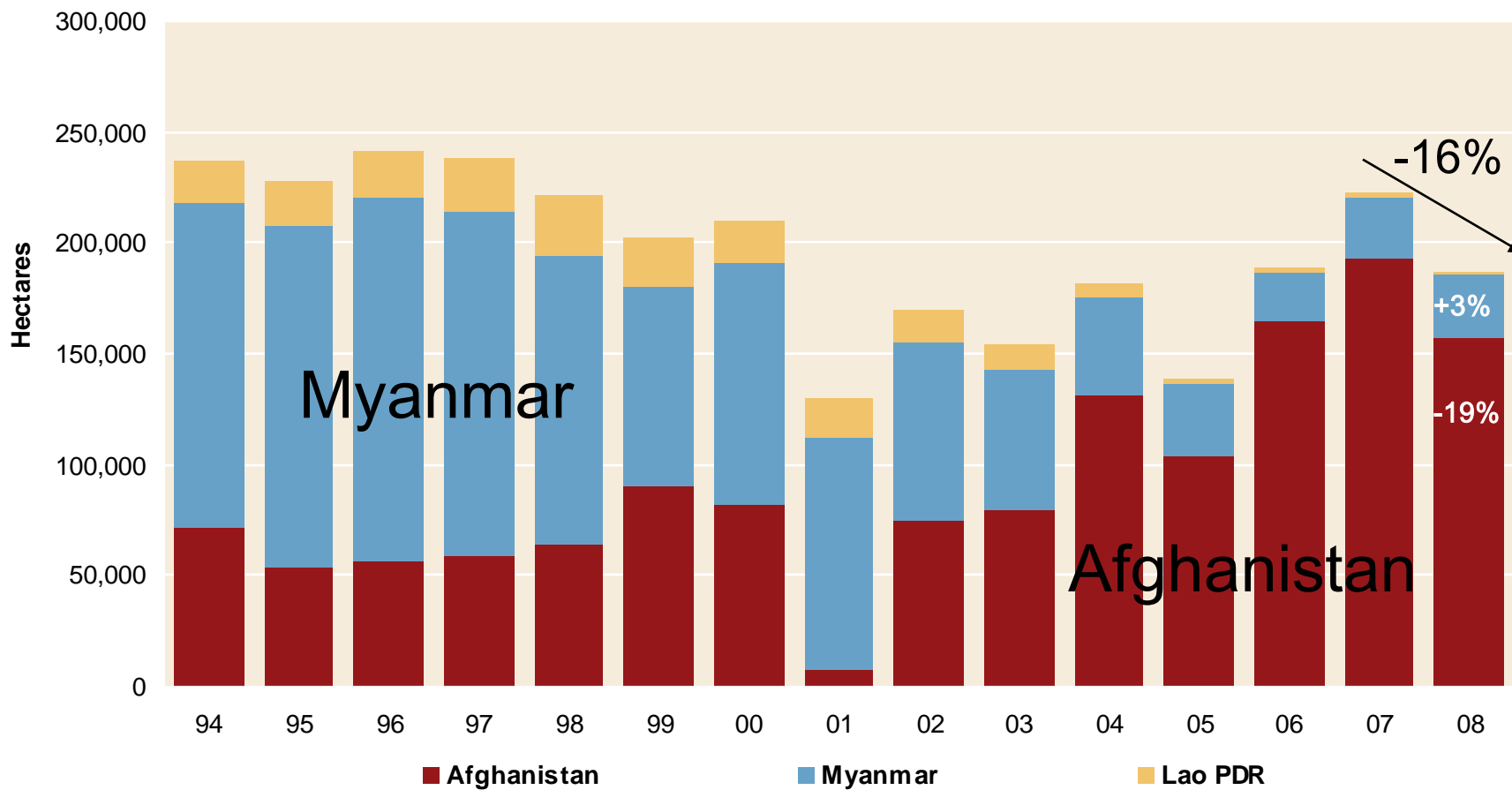


Western Europe: cocaine prices*, 1990-2007

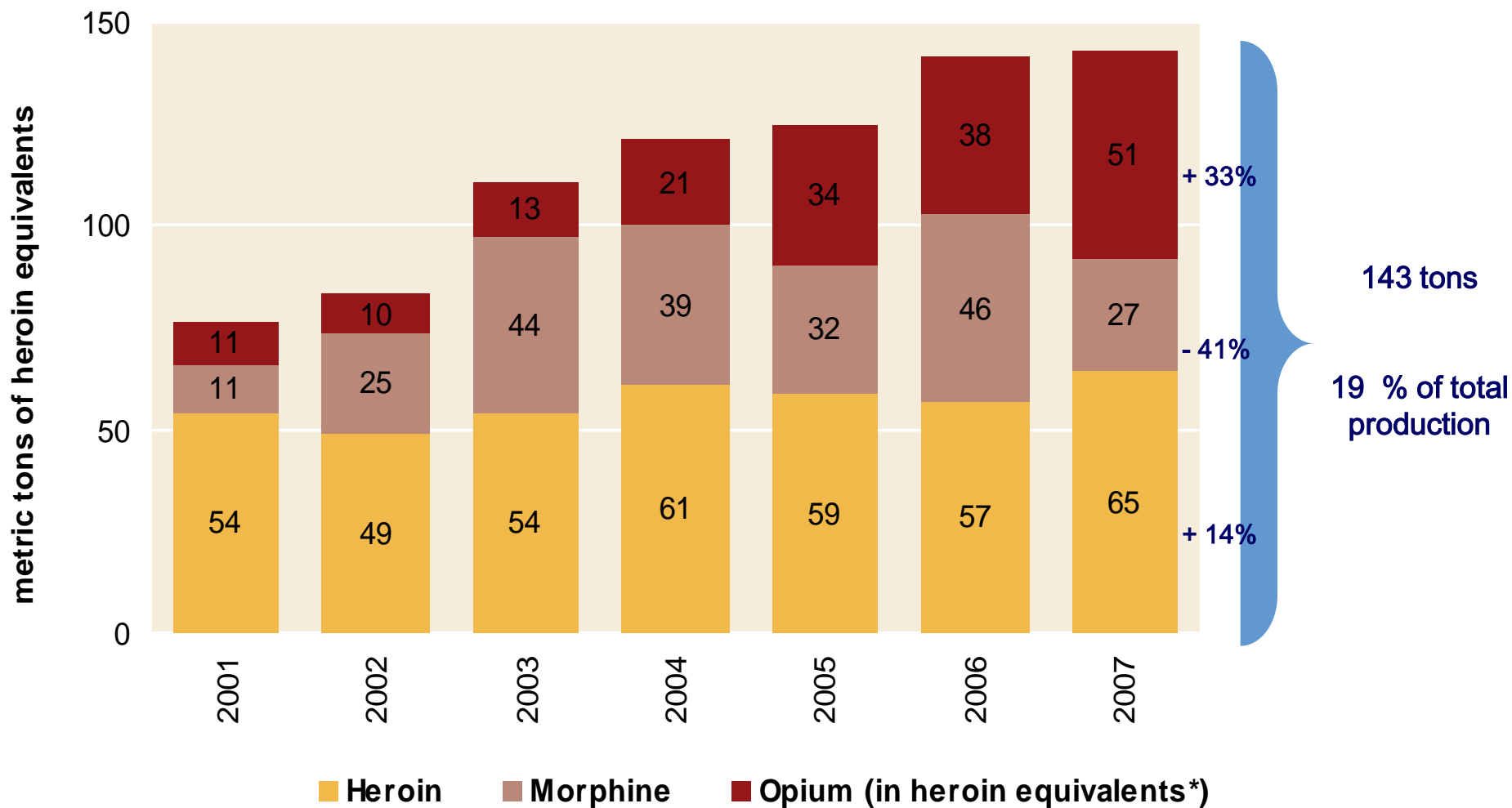

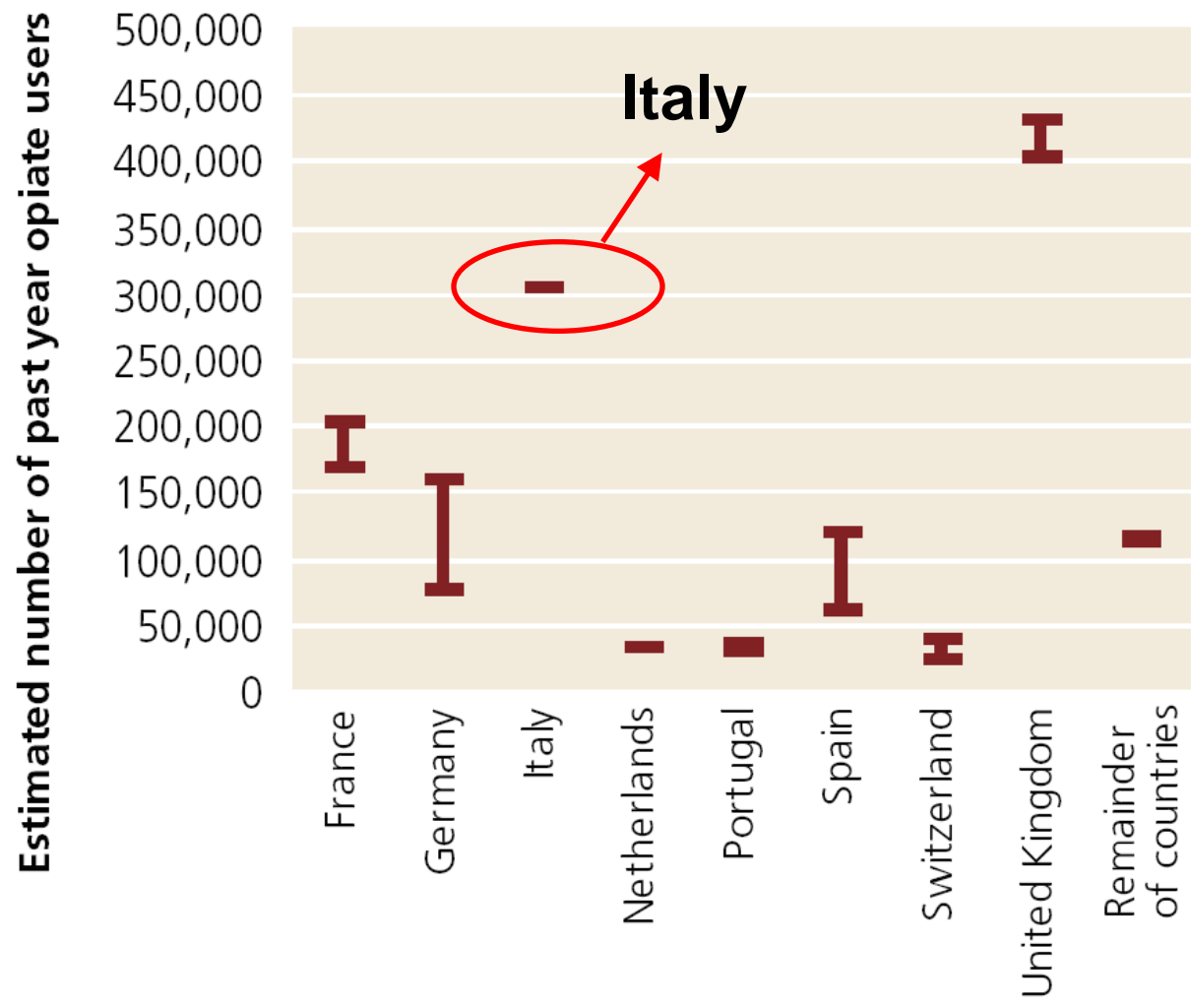
Lower opium cultivation in 2008



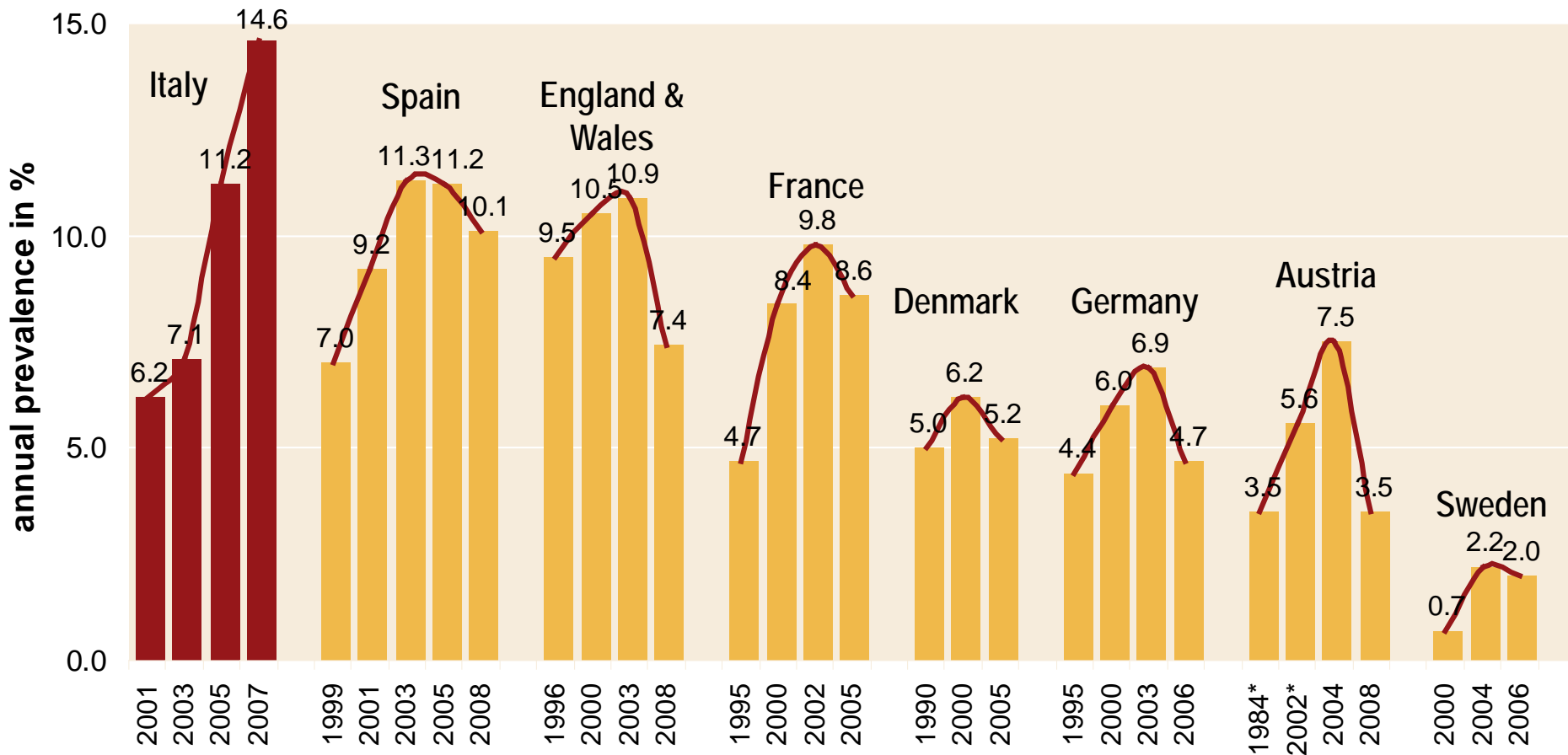
Increasing opiates seizures



Number of opiate users among West European countries



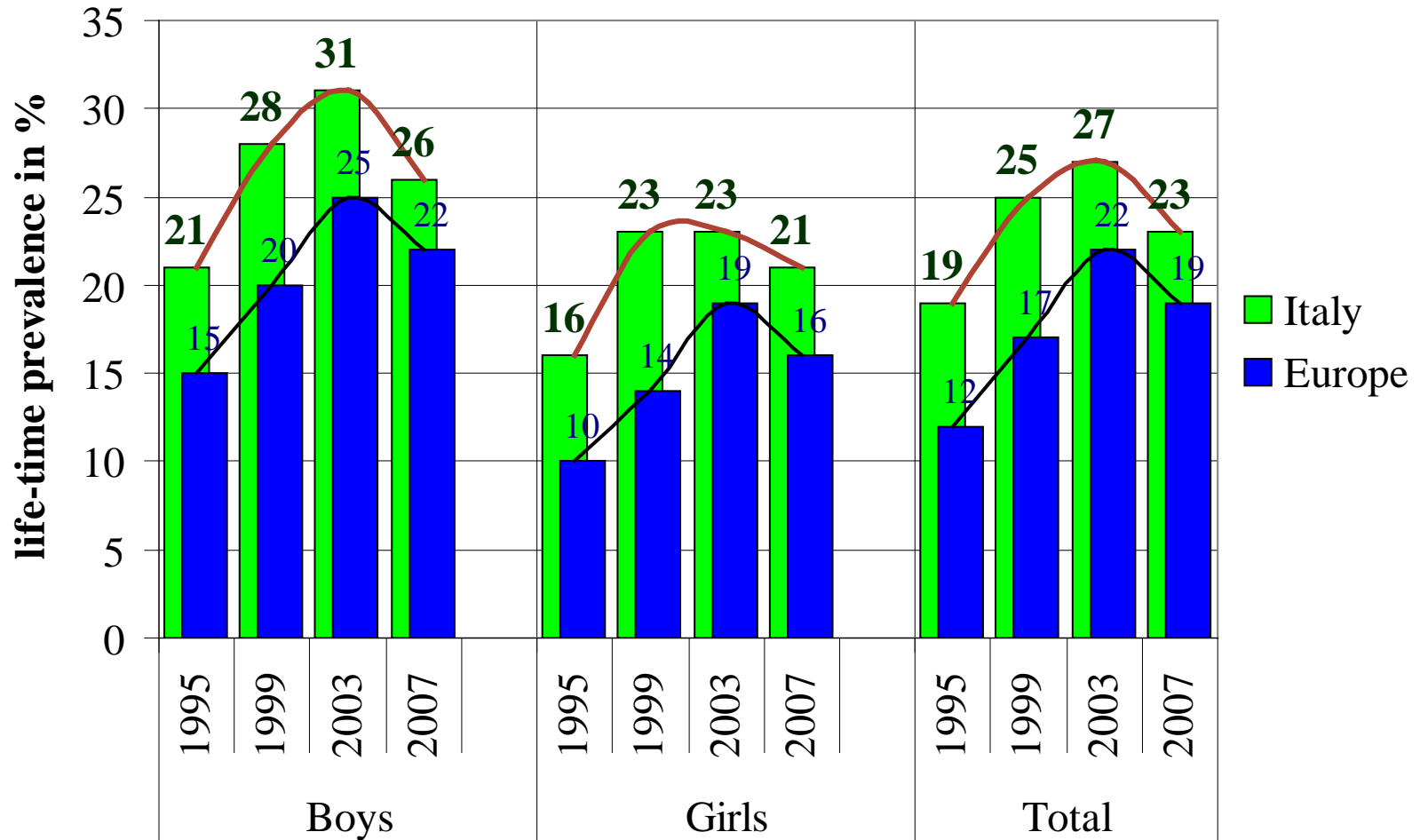
Falling cannabis use in Western Europe – except Italy



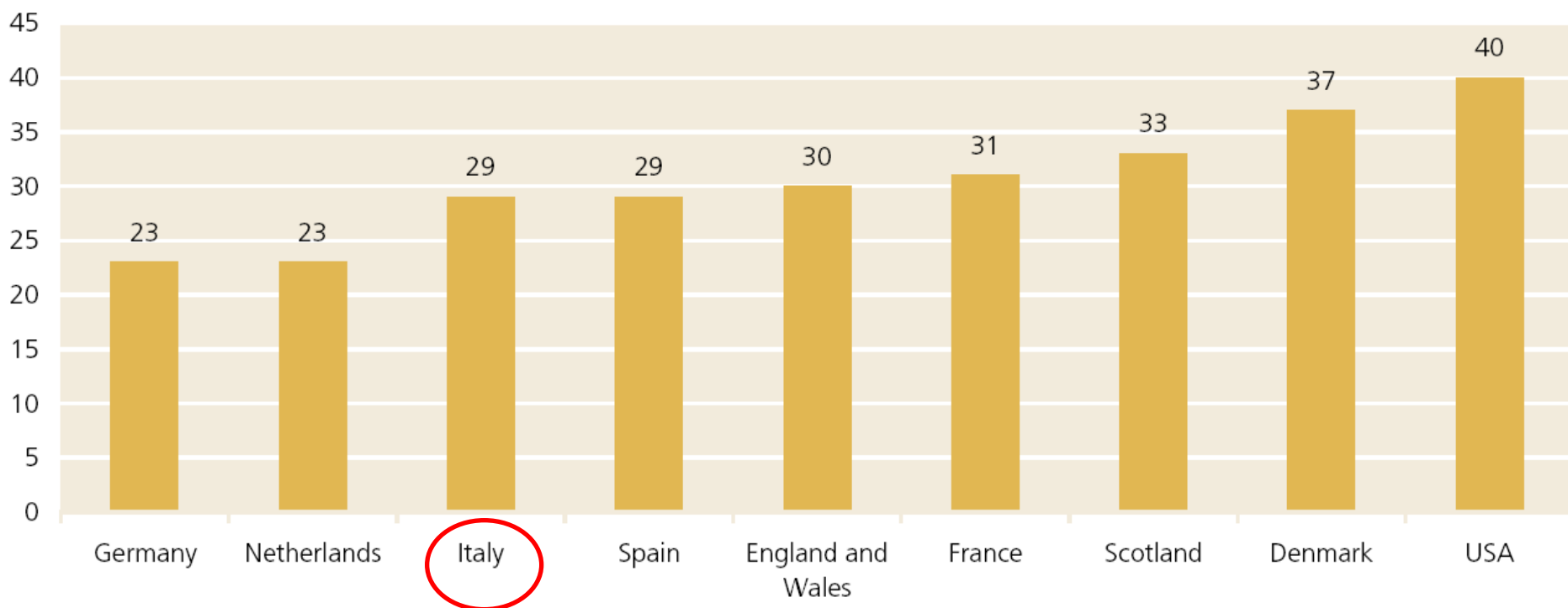
